

BURLINGTON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT IMMUNIZATION REGULATIONS

DPT (Diphtheria - Tetnus - Petussis)

4 Doses - last dose administered after the 4th birthday and at least six months from last dose. *

POLIOVIRUS VACCINE

3-4 Doses - one dose to be administered after the 4th birthday and at least six months between second and third dose. * No booster will be administered before the six months from primary series (clinic physician's preference.)

MEASLES

2 doses – the first administered at one year of age or after and the second administered usually around the 4th birthday.

RUBELLA

1 Dose administered on or after 1st birthday.

MUMPS

1 Dose administered on or after 1st birthday

HEPATITIS B

3 doses prior to school entrance in Kindergarten and Grade 1 are required.

VARICELLA

1 dose on or after the first birthday

FOR ALL TRANSFERS OR NEW KINDERGARTEN TO SCHOOL, THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED:

1. Physical examination within 365 days of 1st day of school attendance.
2. A Mantoux test (for tuberculosis) **is mandatory** for students transferring into Saint Joan of Arc from another country, state, **or** a township within New Jersey that requires Tb testing.

For all students enrolled in Grade Six or transferring into Grade Six from another state or country the following is required:

- 1 dose of meningococcal vaccine
- 1 booster dose of Tetnus, diphtheria and pertussis (Tdap) vaccine

Any new immunization requirements for the 2009-2010 school year will be shared with you at the Orientation Meeting in the spring.
