

## **SCHOOL SUPPLIES 2026-2027**

### St. Joan of Arc School

Please make sure EVERYTHING is labeled with your child's name

### **KINDERGARTEN**

Please use a permanent marker to label all objects with your child's name. (Lunch box, coats, gym clothes, school bags, markers, crayons, etc.)

#### Need First Day:

- Backpack (no wheels) –big enough to carry folders, lunchbox, water bottle, towel, etc...
- Large gallon (or larger) sized Ziplock bag (with name on it) to store student's supplies in for replenishment over the year.
- 1 box of regular size sharpened pencils (12 pack)
- 6 LARGE Elmer's glue sticks
- 3-6 pink block erasers
- 2 Boxes of 24 Crayola (ONLY PLEASE) crayons
- Scissors –blunt, not pointy.
- Lunch Box
- Rest-time Beach Towel and Lovee (stuffed)
- Water bottle (9" or less please so it can fit in your child's cubby)
- Name tag (preferably on a lanyard) with afternoon dismissal info: Bus #, 'Car Line', or BAC (Before/After Care) written on it (Wear for the first week)

#### Need Anytime First Week:

- \*3- Heavy Duty Two pocket folders (preferably Five Star folders) for Home/School, Spanish and their files.
- ½ inch binder (with outside sleeves and inside pockets) for Interactive Calendar use ([A link to a sample on Amazon can be found here](#))
- 1 pack of baby wipes/1 container of Lysol wipes/1 box of tissues
- 1 box of quart sized (zipper) Ziploc baggies
- Over the head headphones to use with their Chromebook (regular jack) (no ear buds please)

- Washable Markers (thick and thin) – 8 or 10 pack.
- Dry Erase Expo Markers – 4 pack thick and 4 pack of thin
- 1 small container of play doh (any color is fine)
- Dry erase board AND eraser
- 1 pack of index cards (to keep at home)

You will be asked to send in money to purchase these additional items the 2nd week of school:

*\*1 pencil case - Please do not send in a separate pencil case*

*\*2 Primary Journals*

Please sharpen pencils and print your child's name on each marker, crayon, glue stick, pencil, etc.... This is a tedious chore but will help us keep track of each child's items when they drop on the floor.

\*\*\*Sometimes we need to replenish wipes and other supplies in the middle of the year and will communicate with parents about that.

### **1<sup>st</sup> Grade**

FOR CLASSROOM USE: ALL items should be removed from store packaging and labeled and organized as follows:

12 sharpened pencils, each labeled at the eraser end with child's name (can be primary fat or traditional style)

2 boxes of 24 crayons, each crayon labeled with the child's name, removed from box and put into its own labeled ziplock sandwich bag. Separate the two boxes into two ziplock bags, as the second box will be used as a back-up.

5 large glue sticks, each labeled with the child's name

1 pair of child scissors, labeled with the child's name

1 8-pack of washable (traditional colors) markers, each labeled with the child's name, removed from the box, and placed in its own labeled ziplock bag

1 box of 12 colored pencils (traditional colors), each sharpened and labeled, removed from the box, and placed in its own labeled ziplock bag (label at the eraser end!)

2 soft pink or white erasers, labeled with child's name

1 12" ruler with inches and centimeters, labeled with child's name

2 highlighters, labeled with child's name

1 tray of children's washable watercolor paints with paintbrush, labeled with child's name

1 large pencil case, labeled with your child's name - BOXES do not fit in the childrens' desks - it needs to be a large, flat, flexible pouch. Please consider using the one from SJA, as it can be easily wiped down with antibacterial wipes. Pencil cases are not sent home at night. Resources for at-home use will need to be available at home.

1 dry erase board, no larger than 9"x12", labeled on back

4 dry erase markers and 1 dry eraser or sock

1 container of Play-Doh (any color)

1 activity or coloring book

1 pair of "over the head" headphones (not earbuds) with a standard audio jack.

All individual labeled ziplock bags should be put into a labeled gallon size ziplock bag. The other items will go into the child's pencil case which is labeled on the exterior.

For uniformity, first graders will purchase all of the required copybooks and folders through the school's stationery supplies. No others will be needed. These include 4 color-coded vinyl folders, 2 primary copybooks, and 1 journal. Large vinyl pencil cases are available for purchase and recommended - last year's can be used if available. No need to purchase copybooks or folders for Spanish and Music - these are included in our supply list.

1 container Lysol or Clorox wipes

1 box of tissues

REUSABLE WATER BOTTLES should have a spout or a straw - no open tops - so we can cut down on spills. They can be refilled during the day, so please consider an appropriate size for first grade.

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Grade**

Please use a permanent marker to label all objects with your child's name and room number. (Lunch box, clothing, school bags, school supplies)

6 - #2 Pencils sharpened

1 dry erase board (approx. 9x12 in)

3 dry erase markers and an eraser

2 highlighters

2 black fine point sharpie markers

2 large erasers

1 12 inch ruler

1 large soft pencil case for desk

1 water bottle

1 small box or bag large enough to hold all art supplies

1 box of crayons - 24 count

1 box markers - washable

1 box of colored pencils

1 pair of children's scissors

5 large glue sticks

1 bottle of white liquid school glue

4 folders (green, red, yellow, blue)  
2 additional folders - kid's choice  
1 marble or similar type copy book for Spanish  
1 pencil sharpener with container for shavings  
1 jumbo book sock

Headphones for your Chromebook

2 large boxes of tissues

1 container of Lysol wipes

Contact Paper to cover workbooks (at home)

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**

Please label all supplies and place all items in the student's ONE pencil case. Extra supplies are not kept in cubbies.

1 water bottle with a spout lid

2 2-pocket folders

2 Jumbo book sox

1 large pencil case (no box)

12" ruler (inches and centimeters)

5 sharpened pencils (No pens)

2 jumbo glue sticks

Big eraser

Pencil sharpener with container for shavings

1 highlighter

1 package of 24 crayons ( in a ziplock bag)

1 box of 10 count markers (Crayola wide)

Scissors (Fiskars brand preferred)

2 dry erase markers

1 Black ultra fine point sharpie marker

Clear contact paper (ready at home to cover/protect workbooks)

1 container Lysol or Clorox wipes

1 box of tissues

## **5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

All supplies must be labeled with child's name

~ 1 homework assignment book. *It is suggested that you and your child pick one out together that matches their organization needs. We use this every day in addition to Google Classroom.*

~ clear contact paper - to cover religion book, Bible

~ 1 water bottle

~ 6 marble copybooks: math, science, social studies, language arts, religion, spanish/music (No spirals, no large binders)

~ 2 disinfecting wipes canisters

~ 1 box of tissues

~ 3 boxes of #2 pencils

~ 1 box pencil top erasers and/or traditional pink erasers (multi packs of each)

~ 2 red pens for marking

~ 1 ruler (centimeters and inches)

~ 1 student dictionary (please no large, hard backed books)

~ 1 pack theme paper or looseleaf

~ 1 pack of 100 index cards with container

~ 1 accordion file folder, 8 slots minimum

~ 2 Sharpie markers, 1 thin/1 thick BLACK

~ 1 large pencil case, no boxes

~ 1 highlighter

~ 1 dozen glue sticks

~ 1 box of 12 thin markers, in ziplock bag

~ 1 box of 12 colored pencils OR crayons, in ziplock bag

~ earbuds, not bluetooth

~ scissors

~ handheld pencil sharpener

## **6<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- 5 composition notebooks (Religion, Science, Social Studies, ILA, Math) **\*\*no spirals\*\***
- Graph notebook with name on it
- Loose leaf paper
- Pocket accordion folder (for all subjects including specials)
- Any color 2-pocket folder (take home folder)
- Book cover (2 large, 1 small)
- Pencils (#2 or lead)
- Pens
- Colored pencils OR crayons
- Markers (fine tip)
- 2 Black Sharpies (fine tip and/or ultra-fine tip)
- Highlighters

- Small pack of Dry Erase Markers (thin)
- Calculator
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Index cards (3x5) with holder
- White out (tape only, no liquid)
- Pencil case (big enough to hold all supplies)
- 2 disinfecting wipes canisters
- 2 box of tissues
- 2 rolls of paper towels

Music : 1 - 2 pocket folder for grades K to 8 labeled Music  
1 copybook (no spiral) labeled Music

For grades 3rd - 8<sup>th</sup> - black fine point and ultra fine point Sharpies

Spanish: Kindergarten - 1 2-pocket folder

1 copybook(Can be shared with music)

5th & 6th grade- 1 2-pocket folder(Can use your accordion folder)  
1 brand new composition copybook (no spiral)

7th & 8th grade- 1 2-pocket folder(Can use your accordion folder)  
\*New students need a brand new composition copybook (no spiral)  
\*Returning students - remember, I have your copybook from last year
